The opening plenary session was held Monday, November 28, in the main auditorium at the headquarters of UNESCO in Paris. Nearly 1200 registrants are in attendance at the General Assembly representing 77 National Committees and 106 countries. The US delegation numbers more than 50 participants, a number of which are making presentations in the Scientific Symposium.

Monday evening, ICOMOS France, host of the General Assembly, welcomed the participants at a reception at the Ecole nationale superieure des Beaux-Arts. A full report on the General Assembly, including the results of the election of officers, will be presented in the December e-news.
